**POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT**

**TITLE:** Program/Teaching Assistant (Internship) for the program *Rehearsing Change: Empowering Locally, Educating Globally*

**SUMMARY:** The program/teaching assistant is a part-time (approximately 25 hours per week) position for those interested in international education, community development and alternative education. The assistant/intern will work closely with the Rehearsing Change Resident Director and faculty on the planning, administration and evaluation of all program activities, including class sessions, excursions, community-based projects, and logistical operations. The assistant will also have the opportunity to plan lessons, teach and conduct academic evaluations.

**SEMESTER-LONG APPOINTMENT:** Early January to Late May, 2016

**COMPENSATION:** The position is unpaid; however, Pachaysana will provide housing, living stipend and all programmatic transportation costs.

**REQUIREMENTS:**

- Bachelor's Degree (or equivalent) + some Graduate-level coursework (or comparable experiences). A Master's Degree is preferred.
- Advanced Spanish proficiency.
- Experience/interest in community-based educational programming. Experience/interest in alternative education programming.

**CHARACTERISTICS OF SUPERIOR CANDIDATES:**

- Degree or experience in two or more of the following: Development; Peace and Conflict Studies; Sustainability; International Education; Fine, Performing and/or Applied Arts; Socio-linguistics; Human Geography; Rural or Development Sociology; Applied Anthropology; Storytelling; Alternative Pedagogy; Social Innovation; Spanish
- Living experience in Latin America (preferably rural areas)
- Experience living and/or working with host families

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** Specific responsibilities will depend on the areas of specialty of the successful candidate. We are a small team and play to the strengths of each member. At this time we anticipate that the assistant/intern will:

- Coordinate logistics of our numerous courses. We work with international students and local community participants; classes and respective assignments require careful coordination.
- Assist with program coordination, such as the planning and operation of excursions and all communications with host families.
- Facilitate continuous communication between faculty, students and local counterparts.
- Plan and teach parts of class sessions in one or more of our courses.
